Phillip Howard Thomas, lifelong Bartlesville resident, was 77 when he passed away Tuesday, May 6, 2020, in his hometown.

Phillip was born August 30, 1942, to Kenneth and Alice (Rickman) Thomas. He was a longtime member of the Southern Baptist Church and grew up attending Virginia Ave. Baptist Church. He was raised in Bartlesville and graduated from College High in 1960. He then attended Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford for a short while before returning home.
