Phillip “Phil” Irvin Valentine, 73, of Dewey, passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2024, in Bartlesville.

Phil, also known as Daddy, Papa, Uncle Sweetie, Uncle Phil, Little Brother, Bro, Phil Pil and Partner in Crime, was born September 23, 1950, in Ponca City, Oklahoma, to Claude Everett and Earline Marie (Cook) Valentine. He is a 1968 graduate of Nathan Hale High School in Tulsa. After high school, Phil worked for public schools before finding his career at the Ford Glass Plant in Broken Arrow, where he worked for more than 20 years. 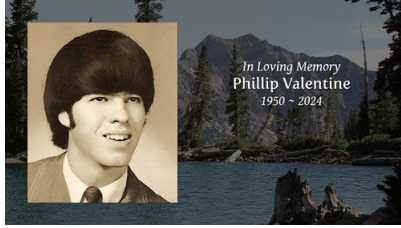
