Reta Marie Lintner, 75, of Pawhuska, joined her husband in heaven on Tuesday, December 31, 2024.

Reta was born February 24, 1949, in Tulsa, OK, to George Bertrand and Elizabeth (Brown) Kennerly. She grew up in Pawhuska and graduated from Pawhuska High School in 1967. She later earned her associate's degree from Rogers State College.

Reta married Robert Carnagey in November of 1968 and to this union, two daughters were born, Lisa and Lori.

On August 10, 1990, Reta married Wayne Lintner and he preceded her in death on December 13, 2005.

She has worked various jobs through the years, most notably with the Delaware, Osage and Kaw tribes. She was employed with the Kaw Tribe's environmental department. During that time, Reta wrote a grant to get GPS markers for the graves. She enjoyed writing grants and her time working for the tribes. Most of her jobs were either in oil and gas or environmental offices.

In her younger years, Reta was very involved in rodeos. She was the first Junior Queen of the Pawhuska Round Up Club. She also enjoyed fishing, bowling and was an expert marksman. She also loved to read. She had a

funny sense of humor. She was giving and would go overboard with buying gifts for people.

Most of all, Reta loved her family and she will be dearly missed.

Survivors include her two daughters and six grandchildren, Lisa Carnagey and her children, Joshua Collins and wife Iva, Gage McCabe and wife Meagan Dashner, Baylee Burkhart and husband Cody; Lori Lane and husband Terry, and their children, Todd Lane and wife Ashley, Tanner Lane, and Katie Lane.
