Richard L. Benning, 85, lifelong Coffeyville resident, died Sunday in Bartlesville.

Richard farmed and ranched his land for a living but his true passion in life was coon hounds and mules. He loved his mules - he would ride them while hunting and he trained them for the various jumping competitions he would take them to.
