



## Richard "Rich" Alan Longo

February 25, 1964 - January 13, 2024

Richard "Rich" Alan Longo, 59, of Bartlesville, died Saturday, January 13, 2024, in Tulsa, surrounded by his loving family.

Richard, or Rich, as he was known to friends, and most importantly Grumpy to his precious grandchildren, was born the son of Joe Longo Sr. and Judy (Weldon) Ferrell on February 25, 1964, in Fontana, CA. He was raised in the Cucamonga area of California and was a surfer and self-proclaimed beach bum in his younger years. He was introduced to his friend's sister and a relationship soon formed with Kelly Jo Garrison. Once he returned home, he worked at Peter's True Value until recently retiring due to his health.
