Rickelle Jo “Meen-No-Quah” Mitchell, 30, of Tulsa died Tuesday in Tulsa.

Born into the Sac & Fox Tribe of the Mississippi in Iowa on Aug. 11, 1984, Rickelle was the daughter of Ricky Mitchell of Topeka, KS. She was raised by her grandparents until the age of 6 then she went to live with her Aunt Barbara Marie Johnson in Pawhuska who adopted her and was her loving mother from then on. Rickelle graduated from high school in 2002, then attended Rogers State University in Claremore.

Rickelle met the love of her life Adam Hornung through mutual friends and they moved to Tulsa in 2005 where she worked in retail sales. Rickelle got engaged to her longtime boyfriend Adam during Christmas 2013. They enjoyed the same activities outdoors: running, hiking, and camping. She found joy in the Lord and her church family, and she was always in good spirits, smiling, laughing, all through her cancer treatments. Rickelle will be missed by all who knew and loved her.

Rickelle is survived by her fiancé Adam Hornung and his son Riley Hornung of Tulsa; her mother Barbara Johnson of Bartlesville and adopted father Ron Brave of Lawrence, KS; two brothers Ricky Mitchell Jr. of Tulsa, Lucian Johnson of Bartlesville, two sisters Delfina Segura of Kansas City, and Casey McIntosh of Dallas, aunt and uncle Loretta and Tom Hernandez of Topeka, KS

and adoptive grandparents Raymond and Dottie Slick of Tama, Iowa. She is preceded in death by her father Ricky Mitchell and grandparents Rudolph and Cecilia Mitchell.

Rickelle's family will receive friends at the New Hope Indian United Methodist Church in Dewey for a traditional Indian wake, on Thursday, July 2, from 7 p.m.
