



Robert "Bob" Tilford McClintock

October 1, 1938 - June 4, 2026

Robert "Bob" Tilford McClintock, 87, of Bartlesville, passed away on Thursday, June 4, 2026, in Bartlesville.

Bob was born on October 1, 1938, in Bartlesville, to Bert Lester and LaUna Genieva (Jones) McClintock. He continued his education at Northeastern State University, graduating with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He was president of his fraternity and was nominated as Who's Who of American Colleges and Universities.

In 1959 he met and married Delores Ann Phillips and to this union three sons were born, Timothy, Brett, and Todd, all of Bartlesville.

After graduating from college was employed by Shell Oil Company at their Nada Center in Tulsa and progressed into the personnel department to the Nada Center's expansion. He gained experience in the personnel field and in 1974 was employed by Brunswick Corporation as industrial relations manager for their manufacturing plant in Tulsa. In 1979 he was promoted to vice president of personnel administration for the sporting division and soon after accepted the position as director of Silver Dollar City in Branson, Missouri.

In 1980 he was employed by Engelhard Industries out of New York for a manufacturing plant in Bartlesville. While working for Engelhard he became

interested in oil leases and the cattle business.

He continued to purchase oil leases and established McClintock Oil and Gas. He maintained the oil and gas business for 18 years, at which time he drilled and produced roughly 400,000 barrels of oil for the Osage Nation. In 2012, he sold his oil and gas business and decided to retire.

In 2021, he lost his wife Delores. In 2022, he met Jacque Guy at Spirit Church and in September of 2022, they were married. From that time, he enjoyed his church life, his many friends at Spirit Church, watched all his grandchildren and great-grandchildren grow, and continued to be blessed. He and Jacque devoted their time to family and church.

Survivors include his wife, Jacque McClintock; five children, Tim McClintock, Brett McClintock and wife Hope, Todd McClintock and wife Angela, Rhonda Yocham and husband Rick, and Dana Braden and husband Bucky; a sister, Leona Long and husband Perry; nine grandchildren, Drake McClintock and wife Christa, Devin McClintock, Britany Lopez and husband Poncho, Chelsea McClintock, Madison McClintock, and Hunter McClintock; 14 great-grandchildren; and a host of other cherished family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Bert and LaUna McClintock; and his wife, Delores McClintock.
