Ronald Joe Sires, age 82, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, passed away February 29, from complications of pneumonia.

Joe was born on October 14, 1941, and was the son of Jim and Bea Sires. Joe attended Wynnewood High School and served in the United States Air Force. In 1962, Joe married Tracy Huitt and raised their two children together. After working for OG&E for two years, Joe was then employed by Public Service Co. of Oklahoma in 1965. After retiring from PSO, he and Tracy continued to operate the local favorite gathering place, Joe's Drive-In, in Shidler, Oklahoma, for many years. After Joe was finally able to convince Tracy to retire and sell the drive-in, they moved to Bartlesville, Oklahoma, where they briefly operated Fat Bubba's eatery, and currently reside.

Joe is survived by his wife of the home, Tracy Sires; their two children, Vickie Hall (Jammie) of Urbandale, Iowa, and Kelly Sires (Marci) of Sun City Center, Florida; grandsons, Jason Hall (Aimee) of Bartlesville, Brandon Hall (Lindsey) of Overland Park, Kansas, Jacob Story and granddaughter Rachel Story, both of Sun City Center, Fla.; great-granddaughters, Lola, Layla and Lily Bloom, Emerson and Skye Hall and Athena Story.
