Sharon Kay Carr, 76, of Bartlesville, died Sunday in Bartlesville.

Sharon was born the daughter of William Alfred and Betty June (Lynch) Thornbrugh on January 18, 1947, in Bartlesville. She loved the fact that she grew up on the west side of town - the neighborhood kids got together to play and have fun, and they named themselves the Bucy Gang. Sharon still considers all of these childhood friends her cousins which sometimes gets confusing because some of them really were her cousins.

After graduating from College High in 1965, Sharon went on to Bartlesville Beauty College. She worked at Vanderveer's in Eastland as a beautician. When her kids were young, she stayed home with Lisa and Bill but when they got old, she went back to work for Applied Automation, retiring after 29 years of service. Somewhere along the way, while out with friends, Sharon met and was asked to dance by Dan Carr. He was a pretty good dancer and a relationship soon formed. They were united in matrimony on August 5, 1988, and made their home in Bartlesville where they lived for the next 33 years and raised their children.

Sharon was proud of the fact that she was part of the first family that settled in Bartlesville, in fact her family co-founded the Carr-Bartles Mill on the banks of the Caney River before Bartlesville was even formed. Together with Dan they

traveled taking many memorable trips to Branson, MO, western New York where Dan is from, Florida and wherever they wanted to take their camper. Dan being a carpenter by trade retired in order to whittle away at Sharon's list of honey-dos. That said, she had to follow behind and clean up any mess those home projects caused. Sharon enjoyed the Gay family reunions, arts and crafts, and collecting her beloved life-like dolls. She liked staying busy and took great care of her home and garden. She also doted on her miniature fur babies, mostly Shihtzus and Chihuahuas, and loved her Zoe and Nala. More than anything else, she loved her family.

Sharon is survived by her husband Dan; four children, Bill (Denise) Gay, Lisa Williams, Brian Carr and Laura White; three siblings, Gary (Linda) Thornbrugh, Nancy (Darrell) Williams and Martin (Julie) Thornbrugh; grandchildren Tricia (Marshall) Gregory and Dayton Michael Carr; great grandchild Zoe; and numerous other family and friends. She is preceded in death by her parents, daughter Lisa Henderson and son Michael Carr.
