Sharon Ruth Tucker-Eifler, 67, of Bartlesville, passed away Sunday, February 8, 2026, in Dewey.

Sharon was born January 5, 1959, in Guymon, Oklahoma, to Louis Marion and Norma Jean (Whitfield) Scarbrough. After completing her GED, Sharon earned her CNA nursing degree.
