



## Shirley Bernice McCarty

April 1, 1952 - August 29, 2021

Shirley Bernice McCarty, 69, of Bartlesville, died Sunday in Dewey. She was a lifelong resident of the area whose roots ran deep and wide, and she was dearly loved. She is no longer in pain and reunited with her precious son.
