



## Steve Bailey Cantrell

Stephen “Steve” Bailey Cantrell, 70, of Dewey, died Monday, November 4, 2024, in Dewey.

Steve was born the son of Wanda Lou (Morrisett) and Bailey Cantrell Jr. on December 29, 1953, in El Reno, OK. His parents were Nazarene ministers and the family moved churches every few years, so he grew up with his three siblings in various communities. Steve graduated from Hutchison High School in 1971 and went on to further his education at Hutchison Junior College and then at McPherson College with a bachelor’s degree. When his parents decided to move to Bartlesville in 1990, Steve joined them, and as they aged, he became their caretaker and advocate. His work centered around drafting and working with architects, custom builders and homeowners, drawing up plans used for inspiration for design and construction. This was a career he really enjoyed.

Steve loved cars, and from a young age he owned sports cars, starting with a Camaro SS. For the past several years his silver Corvette was his daily driver. He loved big dogs and always had one or two to keep him company. At the moment, his pit bull Jack is missing him terribly. Steve’s dogs were always well-trained and loved. OU Football and the Kansas City Chiefs were his favorite teams, making sure to record every Chief’s game to have available anytime his brother David visited. Steve left behind unfinished work and

wonderful memories for his family to cherish.
