Emily Sue Patterson, 82, of Dewey went home to her Heavenly Father on Tuesday.

Sue was born the daughter of Theodore and Mary (Martin) Keen on February 3, 1934, in Delaware, OK. She attended Alluwe schools and graduated in 1952. Sue met Ron Patterson the love of her life through mutual friends. Ron enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps, and while her sweetheart Ron was stateside on leave, Sue and Ron were united in marriage on April 1, 1955. Sue went to live with him at Camp Pendleton, CA. After his honorable discharge the family moved back to Nowata, and then Dewey in 1959. Before Sue was married she worked as a telephone operator in Nowata. She later worked in the Phillips Petroleum Co. executive dining room, Dewey public schools cafeteria and Jane Philips Hospital cafeteria before retiring in 1995. After 60 years of marriage Ron preceded her in death on October 21, 2015.
