



## Sue "Susie" Ann Glasgow

July 22, 1949 - May 12, 2020

Sue "Susie" Glasgow, lifelong Oklahoma City resident who moved to Bartlesville, was 70 when she died Tuesday in Bartlesville.

Sue was born the daughter of Dr. Jack Green and Mary Ruth (Sturtz) Glasgow on July 22, 1949, in Oklahoma City. She was raised and educated in Oklahoma City, attending and graduating from Harding Senior High School in 1967. 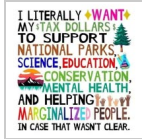

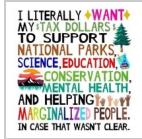
