Tammy Marie Merritt, 44, of Wann, died Friday in Pennsylvania.

Tammy was born on Aug. 21, 1971, in New Orleans, to her adoptive parents William and Betty Lou (Douglas) Osburn. They brought her back to the family home in Peru, KS, and she attended Sedan Public Schools; with the help of Job Corps she earned her GED. Tammy was a devoted mother who stayed at home to raise her four children. In 1995 she was united in marriage with Stanley Wade Merritt and they blended their two families together. Stanley preceded her in death on April 1, 2012.

Tammy met Chris Hadley in 2014 while they were both correctional officers at the Dick Conner Correctional Center in Hominy. Chris would ask her silly job-related questions just to be able to talk to her. She was miffed when this guy who didn't appear to know much about how to do his job was promoted to sergeant before her. In early 2015 Tammy and Chris decided to pursue their shared desire to be over-the-road team drivers. For the past year they have been inseparable, pounding the pavement hard.

Tammy's passions in life centered around her grandbabies. She loved to cook and enlisted her children and grandbabies' help in the kitchen whenever she could. She just didn't try out new recipes, she made her own and even created a new genre of food called Tamanese: Tammy's version of homemade

Chinese food. Over the past year she learned to cook a whole meal in the back of the rig while Chris was driving. Even though her relationship was goofy and weird with Chris, the last few years have been the happiest of her life.
