



## Mr. Terry Wayne Wills

Terry Wayne Wills, 73, of Bartlesville, passed away Tuesday August 19, 2014 in Bartlesville.

Terry was born the son of Clifford Everett and Velma Louise (Johnson) Wills on November 1, 1940, in El Dorado, KS. As an infant he moved with his mother to Bartlesville and was raised by his stepfather Burl Oscar Estes Sr. Terry attended Bartlesville schools, and after his schooling he worked with his older brother as a painter until he started his career with TRW Reda Pump. He retired from Schlumberger after 30 plus years of service as a machinist.

Terry was a son of the American Legion Post 105. He also was a member for more than 20 years with New Horizons Church.
