Rest peacefully, sweet girl. You was taken too soon, but you will always hold a special place in my heart. 💖

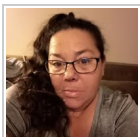

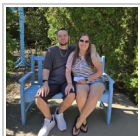

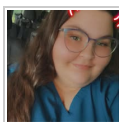
