Todd Eugene Brown, 56, of Bartlesville, died Tuesday morning.

Todd was born in Borger, Texas, on February 8, 1956, the son of Johnnie Brown and Norma Sissel. He was raised and educated in the Dewey Public Schools, graduating in 1974. Todd played sports in high school and coached his children's teams as they were growing up.
