Tommy June Sunday, 78, longtime Dewey resident, died Wednesday in Dewey.

Tommy was born the daughter of John Henry and Ouida Zelma (Grounds) Piltz on October 14, 1942, in Tulsa, OK. At a young age, Tommy and her family moved to Bartlesville where she received her education. Early in life, she proved to be a lively character with a good sense of humor.
