Vida Marie Hall, 86, died Sunday morning at the home of her daughter Joyce in Bartlesville, OK.

Vida Marie Hall was born the daughter of Stephen Samuel and Lee Annie (Cornutt) Baxter on Dec. 6, 1927, in Hollis, OK. While she was young, the family moved by covered wagon to Heber Springs and then to Lindsey Hill, AR before settling in St James, AR. She soon met the love of her life Chester C. Hall and they were united in marriage on January 1, 1946, in Pleasant Grove, AR. They made their home in St. James where they raised their two beloved children Lonnie and Joyce. After 63 years of marriage, Chester preceded her in death in 2007.

Vida attended college in Batesville, AR, and completed her master's degree in early childhood education in Conway, AR. She taught 1st and 2nd grades for 33 years in both Pleasant Grove and Mountain View schools. She moved to Bartlesville three years ago to live in her daughter's home where she could be taken care of while she struggled with Alzheimer's.

Mrs. Hall had a lifelong passion for learning, writing poetry and gardening. She loved all children especially her grandchildren with whom she spent many precious, quality hours. She was a member of the St. James United Methodist Church and attended Dewey First Nazarene while living in Bartlesville. She will be dearly missed.
