



## Virginia Kay Morse

August 24, 1944 - June 9, 2017

Virginia Kay (Wardyn) Morse, age 72, of Ochelata, OK, passed away Friday June 9, 2017, at home with her loving family at her side, after a courageous, three year battle with breast cancer.
