Wilford Don Cragun, formerly of Bartlesville, OK, was 79 and living in Pottsville, AR, when he died on June 17, 2021.

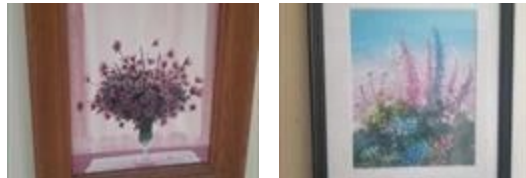

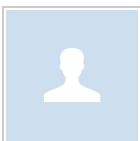

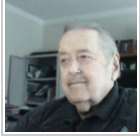
