William "Bill" Franklin Lawrence Jr., 58, longtime resident of Dewey, died Friday in Bartlesville.

Bill was born the son of William and Nancy (Mills) Lawrence on March 10, 1956, in Claremore, OK. As a child Bill lived with his family in Bartlesville where he met his wife-to-be while both attended Sooner High School in Bartlesville. Bill was united in marriage with Leslye Anne Key on December 7, 1974. He attended Oklahoma Wesleyan University and completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business. Bill and Leslye returned to Dewey in 1989. He recently retired from Cessna Aircraft Company in May, after 17 years of faithful service.

Bill loved to ride his Harley and drive his 1965 Mustang, which his son Aaron named "Eleanor." He loved the Lord and his life reflected that - he faithfully served as minister at the First Christian Church in Vera, OK, for 12 years. He also was an avid fan of the Dallas Cowboys. Later in life he took up fishing, a pastime he shared with his three grandchildren. Bill and Leslye enjoyed 40 wonderful years of marriage together. He loved his family beyond measure and will be dearly missed.
