



## William "Buddy" Howard Edwards

William Howard 'Buddy' Edwards went to be with his Lord and Heavenly family on September 24, 2024, at the age of 96. He was born September 21, 1928, to Carl Edwards and Bessie P (Bricker) Edwards. He graduated from Copan High School in 1949 and married Leona C Edwards on May 16, 1951. He served in the Army during the Korean War and they moved to El Paso, Texas, where he was stationed at Fort Bliss until October 1952 when they returned to the Dewey/Copan area where they have lived since.

Buddy was 32nd Mason and a member of Bartlesville Masonic Lodge, Dewey Eastern Star Lodge No 312, Tulsa Scottish Rite and a devoted member of Dewey Christian Church.
