Wil was born the son of Walter Russell and Claudia (McLaughlin) McCauley on December 16, 1981, in Tulsa, OK. The family lived in Barnsdall, OK, where Wil grew up and attended school. He participated in school activities and sports, playing basketball and football. His athletic honors included being selected for all-state in basketball, as well as serving as quarterback and captain of the Panthers football team. After graduating with the Barnsdall High Class of 2000, Wil went on to Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, OK, where he graduated with a degree in Biology in 2006. He furthered his education at the Cleveland Chiropractic College in Kansas City, KS, graduating in 2010 with his Doctor of Chiropractic degree.
